Term of Reference for Technical Assistance for supporting data collection, analysis and reporting.

A. Background

This document provides Terms of Reference for supporting data collection and analysis of a small research on Addressing Unmet Mental Health & Psychosocial Support needs of LGBTQI+ Children and Youth in Bhutan. The research will focus on understanding the mental health challenges faced by LGBTQI+ children and young people, going beyond normative considerations to explore system-level challenges and key barriers in service and help-seeking mechanisms. The specific objectives of the research are:

- To assess the Knowledge, Attitudes, and Practices (KAP) of LGBTIQ+ children and youth regarding mental health service-seeking behavior.
- To understand the challenges faced by LGBTIQ+ children and young people in seeking mental health services.

The research will utilize mixed methods both qualitative and quantitative. The research will conduct online survey with around 120 LGBTIQ+ individuals and conduct In-depth Interviews (IDI), with 20 LGBTIQ+ individuals and five Key Informant Interviews (KIIs) with health care service providers.

B. Purpose

The purpose of the assignment is to support SC Bhutan to finalize the quantitative and qualitative tools, digitize survey tools using KOBO platform, data processing and analysis of both the survey and the qualitative data and writing of the report.

C. Scope of the work

- 1. The consultancy firm will support in finalizing the survey and qualitative tools and digitization.
- 2. Conduct quantitative data analysis and report writing.
- 3. Process qualitative data, analysis and reporting. (use appropriate method)
- 4. Produce draft consolidated report
- 5. Incorporate feedback and produce a final report
